# To benefit from **funded CPD worth up to £500\***, just follow these **three simple steps**:

- 1** Sign up for free at [www.glp-e.org.uk](http://www.glp-e.org.uk)
- 2** Tell us about any global learning work already going on in your school through our online questionnaire.
- 3** Look at your action plan (this will have been generated on completion of the questionnaire), and search our CPD calendar (for courses with a specific date, or 'flexible' courses where the provider can come into your school) to find the CPD that best meets your school's needs.

\*The GLP is funded by the UK government. All schools can join the programme, but funding is only available to Key Stages 2 and 3 in state schools in England, until 29 March 2018. Courses must be attended by 1 June 2018. The GLP in England (GLP-E) is managed by a consortium of partners: Pearson (lead), Geographical Association, UCL Institute of Education, Oxfam UK, Royal Geographical Society (with IBG), SSAT and Think Global.
